AN ORDINANCE TO ELECT TO HAVE VIOLATIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTLINE, MISSOURI, HEARD BY AN ASSOCIATE CIRCUIT JUDGE OF CASS COUNTY, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Section 479.040 of the Missouri Revised Statutes provides that a village may either establish its own municipal court as a division of the Circuit Court or may elect to have all of its ordinance violations heard by an Associate Circuit Judge of the Circuit Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Westline, Missouri, as follows:

That the Village of Westline, Missouri, hereby elects, pursuant to Section 479.040, to have all of the violations of its ordinances heard and determined by an Associate Circuit Judge of Cass County, Missouri.

That the Village Clerk shall immediately notify the Presiding Judge of Section 2. the Circuit Court of Cass County, Missouri, of the election of Village of Westline, Missouri to transfer its cases for hearing and determination to the Associate Circuit Judge pursuant to said statute.

As soon as the Associate Circuit Judge advises the Village that he Section 3. will begin hearing cases, but no later than 6 months after the passage of this ordinance, the Village shall transfer all of its cases to the Associate Circuit Judge for hearing and determination.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage Section 4. and approval.
