AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF TOWN MARSHALL FOR THE VILLAGE OF WESTLINE, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Section 80.400, et. seq. of the Missouri Revised Statutes authorizes the appointment of a Town Marshall by the Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees, of the Village of Westline, Missouri, as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That pursuant to the provisions of Section 80.400, et. seq. of the Missouri Revised Statutes, the Board of Trustees of the village are hereby authorized to appoint a Marshall for said village.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The Marshall shall be the Chief of Police and shall at all times have power to make or order all lawful arrests for any offenses against the laws of the village.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The Marshall can be named by motion duly adopted by the Board of Trustees and shall serve at the will of said Board of Trustees.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon it's passage and approval.


